Dear Edouard,

Sorry about the first telegram. Camden suddenly became saisi d'une terreur panique over the number of works that were to commence a paraitre. You have by now received the second telegram. The number of artists and their oeuvres that you have selected are accepted. Any additional oeuvres can also be comprendre. But not beaucoup d'autres.

As you know, dear Edouard, the catalogue data is now urgent. Titre, grandeur, medium (I don't know the French for medium!) biographie.

The oeuvres selected this end do not duplicate any that you have chosen. I still await the selection from Chicago. Some are already in from Canada, Brussels + Marcel "arien par exemple and about 30 oeuvres from English artists. There will be over 100 oeuvres. ensemble.

Roland Penrose has some oeuvres that he has offered us from his collection.

I think it is going to be an impressive collection. Hardly any of your selection has been seen in England before and will give the lie to 'Surrealisme a mort'
