- 1965 Professorship at the Royal College of Art, Stockholm.
- 1966-70 Board Member of the purchase committee at the Museum of Modern Art, Stockholm.
- 1970 Moves to Bussigny/Lausanne, Switzerland.
- 1988 Inauguration of the first Non-Violence Sculpture at the United Nation's Headquarters in New York.
- 1989 Hit by a stroke, right part of the body and right arm unfit for use. Developing use of left arm.
- 1995 Takes the initiative to the creation of the Non-Violence Project.
- 1997 Lifetime Achievement Award for outstanding contribution to the Art of Holography.
- 1997 The Non-Violence Project receives the Paul Harris Fellow Award by Rotary International.
- 1998 More than 3.000.000 young people, on three continents, has so far taken part in the Non-Violence Project in school and after school programs.
- 1999 The Non-Violence Project receives the Award of Honor by the Safety Council of the United States.
- 2000 Unveiling of Non-Violence sculptures in the cities of London, Trafalgar Square and Liverpool Center. Centro de Curitiba, Brazil and Frankfurt am Main.
- The Non-Violence Project receives the Daily Points of Light Award, a US Presidential award for best community work in USA.
- Launch of the Non-Violence Project in Frankfurt, Germany.
- 2001 Partnership with Volkart Foundation, Winterthur, Switzerland.
- In committed discussions with the Tate Modern Gallery or a permanent display of the Non-Violence sculpture.
- 2002 Launch of the Non-Violence Project in Rio de Janeiro.
