Dear Michel Remy,

Forgive me for not contacting you earlier about the sales of your publications during the Surrealism exhibition: particularly after your kind help with the checking and installation of the exhibition.

I now attach a list of the sales relevant to yourself and Edouard Jaguer from which you will see that 15 of your books were sold. I did not return the rest to Paris but had them delivered to Conroy so that they would be with the bulk of your books. I am arranging for a money order to be sent to Edouard Jaguer for his sales together with a copy of this letter and the list. I understood that you would soon be coming over to London and would be seeing Conroy so it did seem simpler to arrange for payment through him. However, in the circumstances I am arranging to send your money direct to you.

The exhibition went fairly successfully with a total of 5,288 visitors and reviews in the Times, Guardian, Sunday Times, Sunday Telegraph, Times Literary Supplement, Arts Review, Artist, Hampstead & Highgate Express, and Islington Gazette, copies of which I now enclose.

Again, forgive me for the delay in contacting you and many thanks for your assistance. Please let me know if you need any catalogues. I could let you have 20 free of charge.
